Biographical History

Ambrose Pilard (1814-1854) immigrated to the United States from his native France in 1839. Pilard and his family moved often, living in New Orleans, Thibodaux, Louisiana and Vincennes, Indiana where he owned a bookshop and wrote for the *Vincennes Gazette*. While living in Indiana, Pilard maintained correspondence with Louisiana clergy members.

Scope and Content

The Ambrose Pilard letters consist of three letters to Pilard from Louisiana clergy members dating from 1814-1854. All of the letters are in French.
